Report

Indian Council of Historical Research, New Delhi (I.C.H.R) and Omkar Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's Arts, Commerce and Science college organized One Day National Seminar on the topic of 'Unsung Heroes of Freedom Movement in Gadhinglaj' in association with department of History. Founder and chairman of Omkar Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Mr. Rajan Pedanekar was the president of the seminar. Professor Dr. Umesh Ashok Kadam, member secretary of Indian Council of Historical Research, New Delhi was present as the chief guest of the function. Mathadhipati Parampujya Bhagawangiri Maharaj from Nool was also present for the seminar. In-charge principal Dr. Suresh Chavan was also present and holds the responsibility of local coordinator of the seminar. Dr. Pravinkumar Sharma, Assistant Director (Research) of Indian Council of Historical Research was also present as



a prominent figure in the seminar. Professor Dr. Chandravardan Naik, the Head of Department of History of Devachand College, Arjunnagar and Dr. Nilambari Jagatap, the cordinator of Chh. Shahu Maharaj Maratha Research Center, Kolhapur were present as a resource persons.

At the beginning of the program there was the photo exhibition of the great work done by History Department and Durgvir Pratishthan, Gadhinglaj related to forts preservation and conservation, it was inaugurated by Prof. Dr. Umesh Kadam. After it Mathadhipati Parampujya Bhagawangiri Maharaj inaugurated wallpaper presentation on 'Unsung Heroes of Gadhinglaj' prepared by the students of the department of history.

After it, the local coordinator of the seminar and In-charge principal Dr. Suresh Chavan outlined the program by telling the history of Gadhinglaj taluka and also highlighted the work of revolutionaries of Gadhinglaj area as well. After this the program was inaugurated by lightning the Kranti Jyot by all dignitaries. The guests were welcomed and introduced by Dr. Kashinath Tanange. Parampujya Bhagawangiri Maharaj expressed the thoughts on above subject as the main presence. He shared the detail information about Indian freedom movement and agitations which took place in rural areas. In his speech he told that his father Late Anand Mukund Telavekar and other 26 revolutionaries were participated in the revolution of 1942.

Professor Dr. Umesh Ashok Kadam as a chief guest explained the purpose of Indian Council of Historical Research and told how this organisation works. He said that the purpose of the organization is to expose the bright history of India to as many people as possible and to fulfill this intention this organization is funding through various means and he expressed the opinion that we all should take efforts to make known many such events and persons of the Indian freedom Movement that are unsung. After this the program was presided over by the founder and the chairman of Omkar Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Mr.Rajan Dada



Pednekar. He also provided the information regarding unsung heroes of Gadhinglaj area. Vote of thanks were proposed by Dr. Dnyanraja Chighalikar of the opening session.

Professor Dr. Chandrvardan Naik, the resource person of second session shed light on the revolutionaries of Gadhinglaj taluka and told that it's our moral duty to bring such unknown revolutionaries to light. Dr. Nilambari Jagatap, the second resource person told about the contribution of Maharashtra in Indian freedom Movement. Dr. Sambhaji More, head of department of history of M.H. College, Tisangi presided over the second session and expressed his thoughts.

Relatives of revolutionaries from Gadhinglaj area were also present for this event. Mr. Chavan, the yoga teacher also expressed his thoughts on this occasion and said that it is very important to conduct such programs because the whole nation will come to know the work of unknown revolutionaries. After this Dr.Santosh Jethithor expressed his views as a representative of other lecturers. Then the program of concluding and certificate distribution was held for this event Dr.Rutuja Pedanekar-Bandivadekar, The vice president of Omkar Shikshan Prasarak Mandal was present. Vote of thanks of this entire seminar was proposed by Asst. Professor Mr. Bhimarao Shinde. Dr. Sanjivani Patil and Dr. Anil Patil held the responsibility of anchoring successfully. Asst.
